

MBA COVID-19 Procedure – Secondary School Competition

Monday 24 August (3:30pm-5:45pm) in Arena 4

The competition will go ahead during Alert Level 2under the following restrictions to ensure the safety of all those attending.

Key information

- Do not attend if you are unwell or displaying COVID-19 symptoms.
- Arrive no earlier than 10 mins before the start of your match.
- Gather in the carpark and enter the hall together as a team.
- Everyone must wash hands upon entry & exit into the venue.
- To maintain our 100-person limit, the halls will be split into separate venues with separate entry and exit points.
 - o B&M Centre (Courts 1-16)
 - o Ballroom (Courts 17-25)
 - o Girls High Gym will also be used by Girls High teams to reduce the number of players on site at Arena during the afternoon.
- No inter-mingling between halls during each round.
- Contact tracing of everyone will be undertaken with the MBA requesting contact details for all players and attending coordinators/teachers:
 - o Full name
 - Address
 - o Email
 - o Phone number
- No spectators are allowed, with the sole exception of School Coordinators/Teachers.
- Parents must wait outside the building to drop-off/collect their children.
- Please do not mingle after completing the matches as the players for the next round will be arriving to play and we must not go over the 100-person limit.
- Entry into Arena grounds is via GATE 1 only (Waldegrave St.). You will need to walk from Gate 1 to Arena 4.
- ***Teams playing in rounds 2 & 3 please arrive at 4:35pm.
- ***Teams playing in rounds 2 & 3 exit Arena via GATE 4 (Pascal St.).
